A BILL

To require the Secretary of Defense to issue regulations requiring that optional combat boots worn by members of the armed forces wear be made in America, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO COMBAT FOOT-
- 4 WEAR OF MEMBERS OF ALL BRANCHES OF
- 5 THE ARMED FORCES.
- 6 (a) In General.—Not later than 180 days after the
- 7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense

1	shall issue regulations prohibiting any member of the
2	armed forces from wearing optional combat boots as part
3	of a required uniform unless the optional combat boots
4	are entirely manufactured in the United States and en-
5	tirely made of—
6	(1) materials grown, reprocessed, reused, or
7	produced in the United States; and
8	(2) components that are manufactured entirely
9	in the United States and entirely made of materials
10	described in paragraph (1).
11	(b) Definitions.—In this section:
12	(1) Armed forces.—The term "armed forces"
13	has the meaning given such term in section 101(a)
14	of title 10, United States Code.
15	(2) OPTIONAL COMBAT BOOTS.—The term "op-
16	tional combat boots", with respect to a member of
17	the armed forces, combat boots not furnished to
18	such member of the armed forces by the Secretary
19	of Defense.
20	(3) Required uniform.—The term "required
21	uniform" means a uniform a member of the armed
22	forces is required to wear as a member of the armed
23	forces.
